











Should there be a maximum acreage amount (total acres) for each Solar/Wind project?



Should a minimum setback distance (in feet) from neighboring property lines be required for each Solar Panel?




MOST COMMON RESPONSES FOR TOTAL ACRES OF SOLAR OR WIND PROJECTS




MOST COMMON RESPONSES FOR SETBACK FROM NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES FROM SOLAR PANELS




Should a minimum setback distance (in feet) from neighboring property line be required for each Wind Turbine?
